### **Podiatry Services**

Norwalk Community Health Services offer podiatry services for patients as young as six months old through seniors with age-related foot disorders.

**Athlete's Foot** - a fungus that usually starts between the toes or on the bottom of the feet and can spread to other parts of the body. The signs of athlete's foot are dry, scaly skin, itching, inflammation, and blisters.

**Bunions** - a condition caused by misaligned big toe joints that can become swollen and tender. The deformity causes the first joint of the big toe to slant outward, and the second joint to angle toward the other toes

**Corns and Calluses** - occur when protective layers of compacted, dead skin cells. Corns ordinarily form on the toes and calluses on the soles of the feet.

**Hammertoe** - a condition that occurs when there is an imbalance of tendons or ligaments that hold the toe straight, and the toe bends abnormally at the middle joint.

**Heel Pain** - often occurs when too much stress is placed on the heel bone or nerves in the area. It can be caused by walking or jumping on hard surfaces, poorly made footwear, and some general health conditions like arthritis, gout, and circulatory problems.

**Heel Spurs** - caused by growths of bone on the underside of the heel bone. Heel spurs are often due to plantar fasciitis

**Ingrown Nails** - a condition where nails whose corners or sides dig painfully into the skin. They are frequently caused by improper nail trimming, but also by shoe pressure, injury, fungus infection, heredity, and poor foot structure.

**Warts** - caused by a virus that enters the skin through small cuts and infects the skin. Most warts are benign, but they can be painful.

# We treat foot disorders for all ages

Norwalk Community Health Services offers podiatry services for patients as young as six months.



- Children and adolescents as young as six months may need orthotics or treatment for toe walking, out-toeing, warts, athlete's foot, flat feet, and sports-related injuries.
- Adults often experience heel pain, athlete's foot, fungal and deformed toenails, ingrown toenails, corns, calluses, hammertoes, bunions, sports-related injuries, and diabetic foot.
