The Covid-19 Pandemic Is Not Over.

GET THE FACTS:

- COVID-19 vaccines are safe and effective.
- People 6 months and older are recommended to stay up-to-date with COVID-19 vaccines, including getting boosters, if eligible.
- Those who had COVID-19 and do not get vaccinated after recovery are more likely to get COVID-19 again than those who get vaccinated after recovery.
- If you are pregnant or were recently pregnant, you are more likely to get severely ill from COVID-19 compared to people who are not pregnant. Pregnancy causes changes in the body making it easier to get very sick. Evidence suggests that the vaccine causes no risk to the unborn baby.
